Plein Air artists must have their canvases or paper stamped at the Parks and Recreation Department prior to painting your scene or subject. Up to eight (8) stamps per artist will be available between *Wednesday, October 19th and Friday October 21st* during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

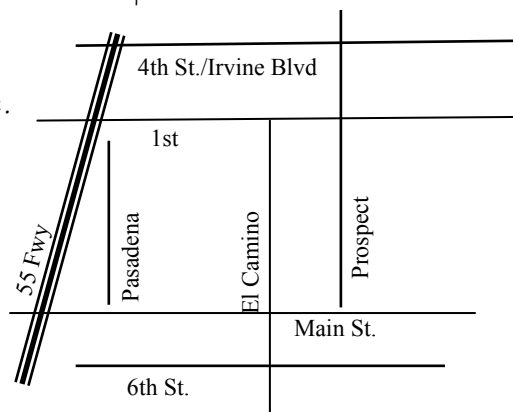
Plein Air Contest Boundaries

Each art piece must be painted in open air, “*en plein air*”, and contain any scene or subject as he/she chooses, as long as it is within the contest boundaries of historic Old Town Tustin.

- Boundaries are within the streets of 4th/Irvine to 6th and Prospect to Pasadena Ave
- Painting from photographs is not allowed.
- No size restrictions.
- All artists must register prior to any work being done.

Cash Awards

1st Place	\$ 1000
2nd Place	\$ 500
3rd Place	\$ 250
Honorable Mention	\$ 100 (2 winners)



Saturday's Schedule

- 11:00 AM - Paintings must be submitted to the contest area
- 1:00 PM - Judging will begin
- 2:00 PM - Announcement of awards
- 2:30 PM - Paintings can be purchased or viewed by the public

Presentation of Entry

- Artists must choose only one painting to display in the judging tent.
- All contest entries must be unsigned and framed.
- Artists shall provide their own easel for display.
- Entries must be left in the judging tent until 4:00 pm
