

2016 Tustin Tiller Days Frequently Asked Questions

Free admission, food and vendors take cash, carnival rides and games take tickets which can be purchased at event. Several ATMs located onsite.

Date/Time:

Friday, September 30th: 4:00 pm to 11:00 pm

Saturday, October 1st: 11:00 am to 11:00 pm

Sunday, October 2nd: 11:00 am to 8:00 pm (Carnival stays open till 10:00 pm)

Parking:

- Free parking along streets where allowed
- Parking at event is \$7. This is a fundraiser for the Columbus Tustin Middle School.

Pancake Breakfast:

- Saturday, October 1st
- 7:30 am – 9:30 am
- Tustin Library Courtyard
- \$5 per person: Pancakes, egg, sausage, orange juice and hot coffee

Parade:

- Saturday, October 1st
- 10:00 am
- Start: Corner of Main and Pacific
- Finish: Prospect and Beneta at festival grounds

Event shirts:

- 2016 shirts \$7 at information booth
- 2016 hats \$10 at information booth
- Past years' shirts \$5 at information booth

Beer Booth Info:

- \$2.00 per 21 and older wristband (wristbands are required)
- \$5.00 per cup of Beer or Wine
- Beer and Wine tickets are for that day only, different colors each day
- Starts serving when event opens.
- Stop serving 1 hour before event is over
- Alcohol not allowed in carnival area.
- Alcohol only allowed in the Food Court and Festival Area. (Alcohol is not allowed in the carnival area.)

Tilleritaville

- Friday, September 30th from 5:00 – 9:00 pm near the main stage.
- \$5.00 per cup of Lime-a-rita or Straw-ber-rita
- No alcohol in Carnival Area.

Backyard Brew Festival Hand Crafted Beer Tasting

- Saturday, October 1st from 3:00 – 7:00 pm and Sunday, October 2nd from 1:00 – 5:00 pm near the main stage.

- No alcohol in Carnival Area.
- Pre-sale tickets can be only purchased at the front counter. Either 5 tastings for \$15 or 10 tastings for \$22 for one day. Our two day specials are 5 tastings each day (Saturday and Sunday) for \$24 or 10 tastings each day for \$40. Each ticket buys a 4 oz. tasting. Must be 21 & over to participate and a wristband is included in the price. By buying pre-sale tickets, an event T-shirt and an event mug for the tasting is included. All items and tickets can be picked up at the alcohol ticket booth that day. Purchasing can be done at the Tustin Parks and Recreation Department until Thursday, September 29th at 5:00 pm.

Baking Contests

- Pre-registration only will be accepted at the Tustin Parks and Recreation Department. Applications are online.
- Cookie and Cupcake Contest: Sunday, October 2nd. Judging begins at 3:00 pm. Deliver cookie and cupcake entries by 2:00 pm at the Community Stage at Columbus Tustin Park.
- Entry fee is \$5. There are two categories: Age 14 and under and age 15 and above.

Tiny Tiller Contest:

- Age: at least 3 but not older than 6 on date of contest
- When to register: Contestants can pre-register or register the day of the contest.
- \$5 entry fee
- Children judged on personality, humor and smiles. Not required to perform.
- Not a competitive pageant, for children to have fun
- Contest Date: October 2nd at 11:00 am (contestants must be there NO LATER than 10:30 am)
- Location: Community Stage (smaller stage by carnival rides)
- 10 winners in each age group receive prizes

Vendors

- Check-in: 8:00 am – 12:00 pm Friday, September 30th, all vehicles must clear the field by 1:00 pm Friday. Vendors ready for business by 4:00 pm on Friday.
- Parking is located at CT Middle School. One vendor pass is included in the booth fee. Additional passes may be purchased at check in for \$10.
- Booths have electricity, but vendor must bring 59ft extension cord, own lighting, and power cord.
- Chairs and tables available for rent or you can bring your own. For all 3 days: \$10/table, \$3/chair or \$5 for 2 chairs
- Awards will be handed out for Best Decorated and Most Spirited booths. Judging will be Saturday after 2:00 pm.
- Ice for Vendors can be purchased for \$5 per 20lb bag at the Information Booth
- Security: All vendors should decide what equipment and inventory to leave overnight. City of Tustin is not responsible for theft, damage, vandalism or breakage. Overnight security onsite, Friday and Saturday nights.
- Clean up: Vehicles will be allowed on the field at 8:30 pm on Sunday.
- For profit vendors must have a City of Tustin Business License, available for the event at the Business counter at City Hall. Please call (714) 573-3144 for more information.

Carnival Area:

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Saturday, October 1st: 11:00 am to 11:00 pm

Sunday, October 2nd: 11:00 am to 10:00 pm

Wristbands:

- Wristbands include unlimited Carnival rides (Does not include Fairway games, bungee attraction, or the bubble attraction.)
- Presale Wristbands may be purchased for \$25 at Parks and Recreation Office, 300 Centennial Way. Presale ends September 29th at 5:00 pm.
- At the event, wristbands may be purchased for \$30 at the ticket booths.
- Individual ride tickets and sheets of tickets will be sold at the event.
