Dear Tiller Days Enthusiast:

Vendor applications to participate in the 2017 Tustin Tiller Days Festival will be accepted on a first-come first-served basis and then must be approved by the Committee. This year's event will be held October 6-8, 2017 at Columbus Tustin Park, located at 17522 Beneta Way in Tustin. Attendance for this event is projected to be approximately 65,000 people over the three days.

Vendors may apply for booth space on or after the time periods listed below:

Non-profit food vendors:

- Applications for Tustin non-profit groups will be accepted March 1, 2017
- Applications for non-Tustin non-profit groups will be accepted May 1, 2017

Please include a detailed description of food items that your group wishes to sell. The Tustin Tiller Days Committee will review all applications, and vendors will receive notification of approval status 6-8 weeks after receipt of their application. In an effort to avoid duplication of items, the Tiller Days Committee will have the right to decline an application.

The Department of Environmental Health of the Orange County Health Care Agency has recently updated their Nonprofit Temporary Food Facility permit application procedure. The new section states "Nonprofit organizations are allowed under the California Retail Food Section 114332.1 to operate up to four (4) times annually. Each event operated shall not exceed three (3) day duration."

Once you exceed four (4) events, you will be required to fill out the For Profit Application packet, pay the appropriate fees to the Health Department, and be subject to an onsite inspection. The current For Profit Application fee for an open food booth is \$108. If you exceed the allotment of events, and decide not to participate in Tustin Tiller Days, we will not refund your booth fees.

All Food Vendors that are frying any food are mandated to provide a "Typical 6 Liter Class K Wet Chemical Fire Extinguisher" in their booth at all times. When OCFA walks your booth at the event on Friday, you must show OCFA that you have a Class K Fire Extinguisher. If you do not, your booth will be shut down until one is obtained. For non-frying food vendors, you must provide at least a Class ABC Fire Extinguisher.

If your application is approved, you will receive your Tustin Tiller Days information packet by mail, including the event layout, check in/check out procedures, and all other materials, no later than September 18th. Hurry, a limited number of booths are available. Submit your application, and all additional documents, with your payment today. We look forward to working with you at the 2017 Tustin Tiller Days Festival and Parade.
