



City of Tustin Adopts Two MCAS Pendleton Helicopter Squadrons



In October, city officials were honored to attend the Change of Command Ceremony for VMM-364 at Camp Pendleton. At the ceremony, Lt. Colonel Paul Kopacz relinquished his post as Commanding Officer to Colonel Stephen J. Conley.

The City of Tustin will support these two squadrons and their families on an ongoing basis, both when the unit is at Camp Pendleton and when it is deployed. In return, the military units will provide community event support.

On August 16, 2016, the Tustin City Council unanimously voted to authorize the Mayor to sign Resolution No. 16-49, which formally adopted the United States Marine Corps Marine Medium Helicopter Squadron 364 (VMM-364) and the Marine Light Attack Helicopter Squadron 267 (HMLA-267).

VMM-364 (aka the Purple Foxes) provides utility helicopter support, close-in fire support, fire support coordination, and aerial reconnaissance. VMM 364 was originally commissioned as Marine Light Helicopter Squadron 364 on September 1, 1961 at Marine Corps Air Facility Santa Ana (which was later annexed by Tustin in 1976).

HMLA-267 (aka the Stingers) maintains a ready-to-deploy, light lift, attack helicopter squadron, capable of fighting battles anytime, anywhere. HMLA-267, while not physically stationed in Tustin, utilized and deployed units from MCAS Tustin on numerous occasions.

BLUE BUOY SWIM SCHOOL CELEBRATES 60 YEARS

ONE DAY PER WEEK WATERING IN EFFECT

As a result of the average rainfall in the northern part of our State, the mandatory restrictions were lifted and each water purveyor was allowed make an assessment of their future water supply. Locally, we are still in a state of extreme drought. City staff and the City Council believe relaxing water use restrictions while the region is still experiencing extreme drought would send an incorrect message to the community. We hope to prevent painting a scenario that would encourage many of our customers to replant their yards and gardens just to be told at a later date that the drought outlook has worsened and the drought ordinance will become effective again. This would be an unnecessary waste of our customers' time and money. We continue to monitor the drought conditions and will notify our customers as conditions change.

Please remember watering is permitted once each week beginning November 1. All Tustin Water Services customers are encouraged to deep water plants that begin to show signs of drought stress (usually

wilting or yellowing). Deep watering plants and trees is the most efficient way to water. For more information on how to deep water plants and trees on your property, please visit information posted by the University of Arizona at <http://ag.arizona.edu/pubs/water/az1298/>.

Even numbered addresses may water on Tuesday and odd numbered addresses on Wednesday. Watering is not permitted during and 48 hours following a storm that produces "measurable rain". This has been defined as 1/4" of precipitation.

We appreciate the community's continued efforts to reduce water consumption.

DON'T LET SEWER BACKUPS DRAIN YOUR HOLIDAY SPIRIT

The holidays are a time of great cheer and good spirits where family and friends gather to celebrate and be merry. A southern-style deep-fried Thanksgiving turkey with gravy drippings and onions sautéed in butter or oil to make the perfect stuffing are all mouth-watering holiday traditions. But most homeowners may be surprised to learn that pouring the remains of these culinary delights down the kitchen sink can cause costly, unpleasant sewer blockages and overflows.

What happens is pretty simple: fats, oil and grease build up in pipes and cause problems. All year long, people pour byproducts of cooking down their sink drain. During the holiday season, it is expected that larger quantities of these fats will make their way to the sanitary sewer system via the kitchen sink. And just as excess fat isn't good for our health, it isn't good for our sewer system. In fact, over time the build-up can block an entire pipe. This can lead to the overflow of untreated sewage into your home at the most inconvenient time possible. Besides the mess, untreated sewage can cause health hazards and threaten the environment and overflows can also require expensive cleanup.

Here are just a few simple tips to prevent grease related blockages:

- Do not put dairy products, fats, oil, grease or greasy foods down the garbage disposal or drain.
- Mix cooking oil with an absorbent material such as cat litter or coffee grounds, place it in a lidded container and dispose of it in a trash receptacle.
- For greasy pans that need to be soaked, first pour excess grease into a container as mentioned above. Then wipe the greasy pan with a paper towel (not a cloth towel) to remove the grease. Dispose of the paper towel in a trash receptacle.
- For large quantities of cooking oil and other fats, call your local household hazardous waste collection at (714) 834- 4000 for guidance on disposal.

UPDATES: TUSTIN PROGRESS

Moffett Drive between Peter's Canyon Channel and Park Avenue: Construction for the extension of Moffett Drive from Peter's Canyon Channel to Park Avenue and for Park Avenue between Moffett Drive and Victory Road in Tustin Legacy is underway. This work includes new storm drain improvements from Tustin Ranch Road to the channel. Construction is anticipated to be complete by November, 2016.

Tustin Legacy Veterans Sports Park: A 33-acre sports park north of Valencia Avenue between Lansdowne Road and Severyns Road is currently in design. This park will include lighted ball fields and soccer fields and lighted tennis, basketball, and pickleball courts as well as children play areas. Construction is anticipated to begin mid to late-2017.

Peter's Canyon Channel: Design for the 30' widening of this channel from the RR tracks north of Edinger Avenue to the southern city limits near Warner Avenue is underway. The widening will take place along the eastern edge and will ultimately include an extension of the Peter's Canyon Bikeway. Construction will also include an extension of the regional riding and hiking trail on the western edge and a new Moffett Drive vehicular bridge over the channel. This work is anticipated to begin in the spring of 2017 with completion late in 2018.

Legacy Park: The bid process for the first phase construction of the Tustin Legacy linear park consisting of approximately 30 acres between the corner of Red Hill Avenue and Barranca Parkway and Armstrong Avenue has been completed. This passive park includes an 11-ac detention basin and a public parking lot at the corner of Barranca Parkway and the future Aston Road extension. Improvements for the first phase are anticipated to be complete in summer 2017.

Victory Road between Red Hill Avenue and Armstrong Avenue: Design for the extension of Victory Road from Red Hill Avenue to Armstrong Avenue in Tustin Legacy is underway. This roadway extension will support the new Advanced Technology and Education Park currently in planning stages by the South Orange County Community College District. Construction should begin in December 2016.

Moffett Drive west of Tustin Ranch Road and Legacy Road south of Valencia Avenue: Design for the short extensions of Moffett Drive west of Tustin Ranch Road and Legacy Road south of Valencia Avenue in Tustin Legacy is underway. These short roadway extensions will allow later access for construction purposes to the new Legacy Academy School Facilities Project currently being planned by the Tustin Unified School District. The grading contract has been awarded and work commenced in October.

Edinger Avenue Well - Phase II Equipping Project: The project is located on Edinger Avenue adjacent to the recently constructed Marriott Hotels. Drilling of a new water well was completed in coordination with construction of the hotels. Construction of the Phase II project, which includes a building to house the well and installation of equipment, is complete and the well is anticipated to be online by December 2016. Once in operation, the well will increase the City's groundwater production and improve reliability of the water system.

Simon Ranch Reservoir, Booster Pump Station, and Pipeline Replacement Project: The Simon Ranch Reservoir is located in North Tustin at the intersection of Valhalla Drive and Outlook Lane within the unincorporated territory of Orange County. The project consists of the replacement of the existing buried, gunite lined, earthen reservoir with a new pre-stressed concrete tank, including a new booster pump station to be integrated within the site, and a pipeline to feed the new pump station and reservoir. Preparation of the CEQA environmental documents is currently under way. The final design effort and approval process is expected to take approximately one year, with construction anticipated to begin in summer of 2017.

Red Hill Avenue Widening and Median Improvements (CIP 70226, 70227, and 70197): Design of these improvements between Barranca Parkway and just north of Valencia Avenue is underway. These improvements are partially funded by the OCTA Measure M2 Project O (Regional Capacity Program projects) grant. Construction is anticipated to begin in summer 2017.

Main Street Improvement Project: The improvements on Main Street within Old Town are intended to create a more pedestrian and bicycle-friendly environment with traffic calming features and to create a strong entrance into Old Town with the inclusion of a gateway entry sign. This project also includes proposed improvements on El Camino Real at various locations to facilitate outdoor gatherings and events. Currently in the environmental phase, construction is expected to begin in summer 2017.

Park Avenue Improvement Project Management and Design: In order to improve traffic flow within The District, improvements are planned along Park Avenue and include the widening of the south side with the addition of one lane between District Drive and Warner Avenue and also improvements just west of District Drive and just east of Tustin Ranch Road. The improvements do not involve the acquisition of additional right-of-way. Design work is underway with estimated completion in early 2017.
