



The Tustin High MUN has over 150 students leading 45 committee competition rooms with an additional 200 parent and student volunteers and about 100 visiting parents and coaches in attendance all weekend. The awarded funds will be used to provide the required logistics needed to run this conference including awards, gavels and delegation plates.

Our second recipient, the Assistance League of Tustin, plans to use the funds received from the grant in the Project TODAY Philanthropic Program. This teen drug, alcohol and mental health program is offered in partnership with Tustin Unified School District to middle and high school students who are identified with an emotional or mental health concern or who have been suspended for first time possession or use of these substances. Intervention and education are included, and parents are given the tools to recognize symptoms and respond when their children are at risk of substance abuse.

Congratulations to both organizations for being chosen as the 2016 recipients. We hope you enjoy your time here in historic Old Town and on behalf of the dedicated Tustin Street Fair Steering Committee, we thank you in advance for your participation in the world's largest one-day Street Fair & Chili Cook-Off.

TUSTIN HIGH SCHOOL MUN

Model United Nations is the world's premiere debate program. Every year, thousands of high school students participate at over 400 conferences worldwide, honing their research, speech, debate and negotiation skills while learning about some of our world's most imperative issues. Top high schools in LA, Orange County and San Diego (private and public) have MUN programs. In TUSD, only Tustin High School offers an MUN program. Tustin High School's Model United Nations Program hosts the world's largest single high school hosted conference with over 1600 participants, including approximately 1400 students visiting from over 35 high schools (last year students for the Czech Republic attended our conference). We have over 150 students leading 45 committee competition rooms with an additional 200 parent and student volunteers and about 100 visiting parents and coaches in attendance all weekend. We would like the funds to be used to provide items used to run this conference; awards (and lunches for our self-hosted weekend conference. Gavel and delegation plates, items used to run the conference are alone quite a bit of money as well as the lunches on top of that. Finally, we will use the monies for paying a large custodial bill for the weekend.






