TUSTIN'S VERY OWN DEAFLYMPIC CHAMPION



Did you know that Tustin has a two-time (or three-time) gold medal winner (or other medal) amongst our staff? That's right! Recreation Program Assistant, Jennifer Haag (Jen), has made the USA Deaflympics Basketball team for the fourth time!

Jen will participate in the 2017 Summer Deaflympics in Samsun, Turkey which will be held July 18 – 30, 2017, where she and the United States Team will compete.



Jen made the women's USA team as a point guard/shooting guard. Tryouts were at Maryland School for the Deaf held on June 27 through June 29, 2016. In her previous appearances in the Deaflympics, Jen's team won

the gold in 2005 in Melbourne, Australia; silver medal in 2009 in Taipei, Taiwan; and gold in 2013 in Sofia, Bulgaria.

The Deaflympics are an International Olympic Committee (IOC)-sanctioned event in which deaf athletes compete at an elite level. Unlike the athletes in other IOC-sanctioned events (the Olympics, the Paralympics, and the Special Olympics), the Deaflympians cannot be guided by sounds (e.g., the starter's guns, bullhorn commands or referee whistles.)

The Deaflympics are held every four years, and are the longest running multi-sport event excluding the Olympics themselves.

We are proud of Jen and her accomplishments and blessed she works for Tustin!



TUSTIN P.D. OFFICER GOES ABOVE AND BEYOND

In early summer, Tustin resident Louticia Terry and her daughter Meaghan went to a nearby shopping center to grab some frozen yogurt. When they arrived back, the two discovered Louticia's adult-sized tricycle had been stolen. Louticia was born with cerebral palsy and her balance and motor skills make it impossible for her to drive. Her trike was her only mode of transportation.

Louticia reported the theft to the Tustin Police Department who dispatched Officer Tom Knotsman. Officer Knotsman understood the devastating loss of the trike for Louticia and her daughter. He took matters into his own hands and went above and beyond the call of duty.

Officer Knotsman contacted a nearby bicycle shop and, at his own personal expense, purchased a new trike for Louticia.

Louticia and Meaghan are more than grateful for Officer Knotsman's kindness and generosity. Officer Knotsman is not one to do things for accolades and remarked that in helping Louticia, he was acting not as an officer, but as a human being.

WHO'S WATCHING THE WATER?

Tustin kicked off summer 2016 with the Water Watcher Drowning Prevention Program. Residential pool owners in Tustin were mailed a flier on water safety, along with a "Water Watcher" tag.

The Water Watcher tags, attached to a waterproof lanyard, promote water safety by assigning the wearer to supervise children in and around the water. The wearer accepts this responsibility and commits to avoiding distractions such as talking on the phone, reading or poolside chats. Should the Water Watcher tag wearer need to leave the area, another adult is given the tag and becomes the Water Watcher.

While drowning is the number one cause of accidental death in children under five, adults comprise 60% of fatal drowning related incidents.

TUSTIN'S 4TH ANNUAL DENTAL CLINIC BRINGS BRIGHT SMILES TO TUSTIN FAMILIES.

On July 16, 2016, the City of Tustin and Dental Care for Children hosted a free dental clinic at the Tustin Family Youth Center. At the clinic, 61 children and adults received free dental screenings, x-rays, sealants, fluoride treatments, and oral hygiene instruction. Approximately \$22,000 in dental work was donated. In addition, the Orange County Fire Authority and Tustin Police Department participated with handing out information to the participants.

The free dental clinic, in its 4th year serving Tustin, began when Council Member Al Murray saw a need for services in aiding children who have had little or no access to dental care. He contacted Dr. Charles Tozzer at Dental Care for Children to see if he could help our community.

UPDATES: TUSTIN PROGRESS

Moffett Drive between Peter's Canyon Channel and Park Avenue:

Construction for the extension of Moffett Drive from Peter's Canyon Channel to Park Avenue and for Park Avenue between Moffett Drive and Victory Road in Tustin Legacy is underway. This work includes new storm drain improvements from Tustin Ranch Road to the channel. Construction is anticipated to be complete by September, 2016.

Tustin Legacy Veterans Sports Park: A 33-acre sports park north of Valencia Avenue between Lansdowne Road and Severyns Road is currently in design. This park will include lighted ball fields and soccer fields and lighted tennis, basketball, and pickleball courts as well as childrens' play areas. Construction is anticipated to begin mid to late-2017.

Peter's Canyon Channel: Design for the 30' widening of this channel from the RR tracks north of Edinger Avenue to the southern city limits near Warner Avenue is in progress. The widening will take place along the eastern edge and will ultimately include an extension of the Peter's Canyon Bikeway. Construction will also include an extension of the regional riding and hiking trail on the western edge and a new Moffett Drive vehicular bridge over the channel. This work is anticipated to begin either in the spring of 2017 with completion late in 2018.

Legacy Park: The bid process for the first phase construction of the Tustin Legacy linear park consisting of approximately 30 acres between the corner of Red Hill Avenue and Barranca Parkway and Armstrong Avenue has been completed. This passive park includes an 11-ac detention basin and a public parking lot at the corner of Barranca Parkway and the future Aston Road extension. Improvements are anticipated to begin in the fall of 2016.

Victory Road between Red Hill Avenue and Armstrong Avenue: Design for the extension of Victory Road from Red Hill Avenue to Armstrong Avenue in Tustin Legacy is underway. This roadway extension will support the new Advanced Technology and Education Park currently in planning stages by the South Orange County Community College District. Construction should begin late 2016.

Moffett Drive west of Tustin Ranch Road and Legacy Road south of Valencia Avenue: Design for the short extensions of Moffett Drive west of Tustin Ranch Road and Legacy Road south of Valencia Avenue in Tustin Legacy is underway. These short roadway extensions will allow later access for construction purposes to the new Legacy Academy School Facilities Project currently being planned by the Tustin Unified School District. Grading is anticipated to start late 2016.

Edinger Avenue Well - Phase II Equipping Project: The project is located on Edinger Avenue adjacent to the recently constructed Marriott Hotels. Drilling of a new water well was completed in coordination with construction of the hotels. Construction of the Phase II project, which includes a building to house the well and installation of

equipment, is underway and is anticipated to be complete by the end of summer 2016. Once in operation, the well will increase the City's groundwater production and improve reliability of the water.

Simon Ranch Reservoir, Booster Pump Station, and Pipeline Replacement Project: The Simon Ranch Reservoir is located in North Tustin at the intersection of Valhalla Drive and Outlook Lane within the unincorporated territory of Orange County. The project consists of the replacement of the existing buried, gunite lined, earthen reservoir with a new pre-stressed concrete tank, including a new booster pump station to be integrated within the site, and a pipeline to feed the new pump station and reservoir. Preparation of the CEQA environmental documents is currently under way. The final design effort and approval process is expected to take approximately one year, with construction anticipated to begin in spring of 2017.

Red Hill Avenue Widening and Median Improvements (CIP 70226, 70227, and 70197): Design of these improvements between Barranca Parkway and just north of Valencia Avenue is underway. These improvements are partially funded by the OCTA Measure M2 Project O (Regional Capacity Program projects) grant. Construction is anticipated to begin in 2017.

Main Street Improvement Project: The improvements on Main Street within Old Town are intended to create a more pedestrian and bicycle-friendly environment with traffic calming features and to create a strong entrance into Old Town with the inclusion of a gateway entry sign. This project also includes proposed improvements on El Camino Real at various locations to facilitate outdoor gatherings and events. Issuance of a notice to proceed for the design work occurred in late June, 2016.

Park Avenue Improvement Project Management and Design: In order to improve traffic flow within The District, improvements are planned along Park Avenue and include the widening of the south side with the addition of one lane between District Drive and Warner Avenue and also improvements just west of District Drive and just east of Tustin Ranch Road. The improvements do not involve the acquisition of additional right-of-way. Design work began in July, 2016.
