TUSTIN, Calif. – The Tustin City Council will change their council meetings from the first and third Mondays of the month to the first and third Tuesdays of the month. Tuesday meetings will begin March 6, 2007. The meeting place and time will remain the same. Tustin council meetings are held in the Council Chambers in the Clifton C. Miller Community Center located at 300 Centennial Way in Tustin. Council meetings are called to order at 5:30 p.m. for Closed Session with Regular Meeting at 7:00 p.m.

Not only does it give Council an extra day to study items on the agenda and have their questions answered, it gives the public more time to give us comments and participate in the happenings of local government.
