TUSTIN POLICE TO HOST “TIP-A-COP” PROGRAM TO RAISE FUNDS FOR SPECIAL OLYMPICS

TUSTIN, Calif. – On Saturday, April 17 at the Red Robin located at 3015 El Camino Real in the Tustin Market Place, Tustin Police Officers and Police Personnel will be working for tips for the Special Olympics. Police department members will be working two shifts, 11 am – 3 pm and 4 pm – 8 pm, and will be helping to seat patrons, assist servers with taking orders, delivering meals to tables and visiting with diners. Tips can be placed in special envelopes at each table. Donations will be used to support the programs of the Special Olympics and all tips are tax-deductible.

In a statement, the Special Olympics describe the program as: Tip-A-Cop has been a favorite way for officers to raise money, and the public loves to have the officers wait on them hand and foot. Tip-A-Cop events are one of the main fundraisers for the Law Enforcement Torch Run®, which is one of the largest fundraising arms of Special Olympics Southern California.

In June, the police department will participate in the 25-year tradition with Special Olympic participants as the torch runs through Tustin.
