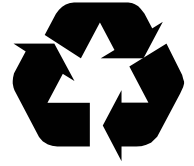




NOTICE TO PERMIT APPLICANTS **CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION** **DEBRIS RECYCLING**



Tustin City Code Section 4327 requires project permittees to recycle or divert from landfills 50% of the waste created by certain projects.

Waste Disposal and Diversion Reporting Requirement.

All construction, demolition, and renovation projects with a valuation of \$50,000 or greater shall be required to divert at least 50% of all project-related C&D Debris.

All Project permittees shall:

- 1) Prior to a permit being issued, submit a waste management plan for approval by the City.
- 2) Upon project completion, provide to the Building Official all Project related C&D Debris collection, disposal and diversion information in the City prescribed form.
- 3) The following projects are exempted from the requirements of this Section:
 - a) Work for which only a plumbing, electrical, or mechanical permit is required.
 - b) Seismic tie-down projects.
 - c) Installation of pre-fabricated patio enclosures and covers where no foundation or other structural building modifications are required.
 - d) Installation of pre-fabricated accessories such as signs or antennas where no structural building modifications are required.
