The Tustin Police Department is currently accepting applications for the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training course. Classes for the free training are held Wednesday nights from 6:30-9:30pm beginning March 8-April 26.

The CERT training course is a 24-hour Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) approved program that provides participants with basic skills to respond to family, neighborhood and community needs in the aftermath of a disaster, when emergency services may not be immediately available.

By working together, CERT members can assist in saving lives and protecting property using the basic techniques taught in the course. Training includes first aid, CPR, light search and rescue, and disaster preparedness. Course instruction is provided by the Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) and Tustin Police Department.
