TUSTIN, Calif. – The Orange County Fair and Event Center has designated Wednesday, July 19, 2017, as Tustin Day. To commemorate this special designation, a community flag raising and National Anthem ceremony will take place at 12:30 p.m. at the Hanger inside the Fairgrounds. Tustin Mayor Dr. Allan Bernstein, along with Council Member Rebecca “Beckie” Gomez and Council Member Charles E. “Chuck” Puckett, will be present for the ceremony. The Orange County Fairgrounds are located at 88 Fair Drive, Costa Mesa, CA.

From 1949 to the present, the OC Fair has grown from a small, community celebration to a 23-day festival that is one of Orange County’s most eagerly awaited annual events. This year’s event runs from July 14 through August 13, 2017.
