Rick Darnall served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1968 to 1972. After graduating from boot camp at MCRD San Diego, Rick completed electronic training to support the TPS-22 radar (MOS 5942). In 1971 Rick served at MCAS Tustin as part of MACS-3. After tours in Iwakuni and Okinawa, Rick returned to MCAS Tustin as part of MCTSSA until he was honorably discharged in 1972. During his service Rick earned the Meritorious Unit Commendation Ribbon, Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Medal, Outstanding Volunteer Medal, Overseas Service Ribbon, Cold War Commemorative Medal and Expert Rifle Badge.

After his service Rick attended Control Data Institute and spent 41 years in various roles with Burroughs/Unisys Corporation in Nebraska, Colorado, Montana, Nevada and California, retiring in 2014.

Rick continues to serve his community and support veterans today. Since 2015 Rick has served as a member of Semper Fi #1 Memorial Honor Detail providing military honors at Riverside National Cemetery for veterans from all branches of the military.
