



2025 Tustin Street Fair and Chili Cook-Off

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When is the event?

A: Sunday, June 1, 2025, 11:00am to 6:00pm.

Q: Where will it take place?

A: Old Town Tustin including Peppertree Park – *see map on website.*

Q: Will there be admission cost?

A: Admission is FREE.

Q: Are there other costs?

A: Yes.

- Non-profit food vendors have varying prices for their food/beverage items. Most accept cash only while some do offer cashless options.
- Chili tickets are \$1 per tasting. Cash and credit card payments are accepted.
- Alcohol is \$9 for beer, wine, seltzer, or “Twisted Tea”. An alcohol wristband is required for all adult beverages; it is a one-time cost of \$2. Cash and credit card payment is accepted.
- Craft and commercial vendors also have varying costs for their products. Method of payment varies and may include cash and/or credit card.

Q: Will streets be closed?

A: Yes.

- Thursday, May 29, at 5:00pm to Monday, June 2, at 1:00pm:
 - Farmers Market Lot
- Saturday, May 31, from 4:00pm to Sunday, June 1, at 10:00pm:
 - El Camino Real from First Street to Second Street
- Sunday, June 1, from 4:00am to 10:00pm:
 - El Camino Real from Sixth Street to First Street

- C Street from Main to First Street
 - Main Street from B to Prospect
 - Third Street from C to Prospect
 - Second Street from C to Prospect
- Sunday, June 1, from 6:00am to 8:00pm:
 - B Street from Second Street to First Street

Q: How do I access the event?

A: The event will not be gated. Access is available by foot only.

Q: What bands are playing?

A: Live music will be played throughout three different stages. Please visit the event's entertainment page at www.tustinchilicookoff.com for more information.

Q: How early can I show up to the event?

A: The event will kick off at 11:00am. We recommend you make time to find parking.

Q: Can I bring my own lawn chair and/or blanket to the event?

A: Yes, if you plan on sitting down to listen to the live music at Peppertree Park. The park has limited benches; however, we recommend you bring a beach chair or blanket and enjoy the lawn area.

Q: Can I set up an umbrella and/or canopy?

A: Canopies are **not** allowed; however, umbrellas are encouraged. Limited umbrellas will be placed throughout Peppertree Park to allow for some shade for those choosing to sit and listen to the live music.

Q: Will the playground be open?

A: Yes. Parents are asked to supervise their children.

Q: Are there any attractions for children?

A: Yes, there will be a Family Fun Zone with inflatables and other attractions. These attractions will be provided by Fun Services at a fee. Cash only.

Q: Is the event dog friendly?

A: Although we love dogs, we highly encourage that you protect your dogs during the hot and humid weather. Always bring a doggy water bottle and ensure you protect your dog's paws from the hot asphalt. Two shaded doggy zones with water bowls will be dedicated as respite areas for your dogs. One at Peppertree Park in the grass and the other, a satellite area with turf on El Camino Real and Third Street.

Q: Where can I park?

A: Public parking is available as follows:

- Behind Rutabegorz Restaurant at Stevens Square (access from C and Sixth Streets)
- At the Water Facility parking lot on 275 Main Street (corner of Prospect and Third Street)
- On side streets (park at your own risk)
- Civic Center, 300 Centennial Way, Tustin 92780
- Columbus Tustin Recreation Center (17522 Beneta Way, Tustin 92780); there will be a shuttle to the event and back, starting at 10:30am with the last shuttle departing to CTRC at 6:15pm
- ***Parking in private commercial lots (e.g. El Camino Plaza) is discouraged unless permitted by the owner of the premises.***
