#### **Q. When is it?**

**New! Preview Night! \$2 per ride!** - Thursday, October 4<sup>th</sup>: 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm  
Friday, October 5<sup>th</sup>: 4:00 pm to 11:00 pm  
Saturday, October 6<sup>th</sup>: 11:00 am to 11:00 pm  
Sunday, October 7<sup>th</sup>: 11:00 am to 8:00 pm (Carnival stays open until 10:00 pm)

#### **Q. Where Can I Park?**

- Free parking along streets where allowed
- Parking at event is \$10. This is a fundraiser for the Columbus Tustin Middle School.

#### **Q. When and Where is the Pancake Breakfast?**

- Saturday, October 6<sup>th</sup>
- 7:30 am to 9:30 am
- Tustin Library Courtyard, 345 E. Main St.
- \$6 per person: Pancakes, egg, sausage, orange juice and hot coffee

- Saturday, October 6<sup>th</sup>
- 10:00 am
- Start: Corner of Main and Pacific
- Finish: Prospect and Beneta at festival grounds

**Q. Will there be a Beer Booth?**

- \$2.00 per 21 and older wristband (wristbands are required)
- \$6.00 per cup of Beer or Wine
- Beer and Wine tickets are for that day only, different colors each day
- Starts serving when event opens.
- Stop serving 1 hour before event is over
- Alcohol not allowed in carnival area.
- Alcohol only allowed in the Food Court and Festival Area.
- Accepting credit cards for payment

**Q. When is the Backyard Brew Festival Hand Crafted Beer Tasting?**

- Saturday, October 6th from 3:00 to 7:00 pm and Sunday, October 7th from 1:00 to 5:00 pm near the main stage.
- No alcohol in Carnival Area.

**Q. What about the Tiny Tiller Contest?**

- Contest Date: October 6th at 2:00 pm (contestants must be there NO LATER than 1:30 pm)
- Age: 3 to 6 years old.
- How to register: Contestants can pre-register at the Parks and Recreation Department at City Hall or register at the day of event at the Community Stage.
- \$5 entry fee
- Children judged on personality, humor and smiles. Not required to perform.
- Not a competitive pageant, for children to have fun
- Location: Community Stage
- 10 winners in each age group receive prizes
- All contestants invited to Princess Party at 3pm.

**Q. I'm a Vendor. What Do I Need to Know?**

- Check-in: 8:00 am to 12:00 pm Friday, October 5<sup>th</sup> – all vehicles must clear the field by 1:00 pm. Vendors must be ready for business by 4:00 pm.
- Parking is located at CT Middle School. One vendor pass is included in the booth fee. Additional passes may be purchased at check in for \$10.
- Booths have electricity, but vendor must bring 59ft extension cord, own lighting, and power cord.
- Chairs and tables available for rent for all 3 days: \$10/table, \$3/chair or \$5 for 2 chairs or you may bring your own.
- Awards will be handed out for Best Decorated and Most Spirited booths. Judging will be Saturday after 2:00 pm.
- Ice for Vendors can be purchased for \$5 per 20lb bag at the Information Booth
- Security: All vendors should decide what equipment and inventory to leave overnight. City of Tustin is not responsible for theft, damage, vandalism or breakage. Overnight security onsite, Friday and Saturday nights.
- Clean up: Vehicles will be allowed on the field at 9:00 pm on Sunday.
- Profit vendors must have a City of Tustin Business License, available for the event at the Business counter at City Hall. Please call (714) 573-3144 for more information.

**Wristbands:**

- Wristbands include unlimited Carnival rides (Does not include Fairway games).
- Presale Wristbands may be purchased for \$25 at Parks and Recreation Office, 300 Centennial Way. These are one-day wristbands. Presale ends October 5th at 5:00 pm.
- At the event, wristbands may be purchased for \$30 at the ticket booths.
- Individual ride tickets and sheets of tickets will be sold at the event.
