- * Food and Vendors Take Cash Only * Several ATMs Are Located On-Site *

Q. Where and when is it?

- Columbus Tustin Park, 17522 Beneta Way, Tustin 92780
- Friday, October 3: 4:00 to 11:00 pm
- Saturday, October 4: 11:00 am to 11:00 pm
- Sunday, October 5: 12:00 to 8:00 pm (Carnival stays open until 10:00 pm)

Q. Where can I park?

- Free parking along streets where allowed
 - Parking at the event is \$15 (Columbus Tustin Middle School fundraiser)

Q. What is the schedule for the shuttle service?

- Shuttle service to or from Tustin Area Senior Center parking lot is as follows:

 - Sunday, October 6, 2:00 – 8:30 pm
 - Last Shuttle TASC to Tiller Days: 7:00 pm
 - Last Shuttle Tiller Days to TASC: 8:15 PM

- Saturday, October 4 at 10:00 am
- Start: Corner of Main Street and Pacific Street
- Finish: Prospect Avenue and Beneta Way at Festival grounds

- Tiller Days merchandise will be available at the Information Booth during the even
- Cash and card accepted

Q. Will there be a Beer and Wine?

- A wristband is required to consume alcohol. \$2 per wristband (available to attendees 21 and older only).
- Beer and wine tickets are \$9 each (each ticket redeemable for 1 drink, limit 2 tickets/drinks per purchase). Tickets must be purchased by attendees with a wristband to be exchanged for alcoholic drinks
- Beer and Wine tickets are for the day of purchase only (different colors each day)
- Service begins when the event opens
- Service ends 1 hour before the event is over
- No alcohol in Carnival area
- Credit cards and cash accepted for payment

Q. When is the Backyard Brew Festival Hand-Crafted Beer Tasting?

- Sunday, October 5, from 1:00 to 6:00 pm near the Sports Zone
- No alcohol in the Carnival area

Q. When is Kids Say the Cutest Things?

- Contest Date: Sunday, October 5 at 1:30 pm (contestants must be there NO LATER than 12:30 pm)
- Location: Community Stage
- Age: 4 to 6 years old as of October 5, 2025.
- Children's smiles, personality, and humor are on display-not required to perform
- Not a competitive pageant-just for fun

Q. I'm a Vendor. What Do I Need to Know?

- Check-in: 8:00 am to 12:00 pm Friday, October 3 – all vehicles must clear the field by 1:00 pm. Vendors must be ready for business by 4:00 pm.
- Parking is located at Columbus Tustin Middle School track in field. One vendor pass is included in the booth fee.
Additional passes may be purchased at check-in for \$10.
- Booths have electricity, but vendor must bring 59ft extension cord, own lighting, and power cords.
- Chairs and tables available for rent for all three days: \$10/table or \$5 for two chairs (or you may bring your own). Tables and chairs are limited.
- Awards will be handed out for Best Decorated and Most Spirited booths. Judging will be Saturday after 2:00 pm.
- Ice for vendors can be purchased for \$6 per 20 lb. bag from the Information Booth
- Security: Overnight security will be on-site Friday and Saturday nights. All vendors should decide what equipment and inventory to leave overnight. The city of Tustin is not responsible for theft, damage, vandalism, or breakage
- Clean up: Vehicles will be allowed on the field at 9:00 pm on Sunday
- For-profit vendors must have a City of Tustin Business License available for the event at the Business counter at City Hall. Please call (714) 573-3144 for more information

Wristbands:

- Presale One-Day Unlimited Rides Wristbands may be purchased for \$40 at the Parks and Recreation Office, 300 Centennial Way **while supplies last**. Presale dates are: September 2 - October 3-the **presale ends at 3:00 pm on October 3, 2025**
- At the event, wristbands may be purchased for \$45 at the ticket booths
- Individual ride tickets and sheets of tickets will be sold at the event

Q. Is Smoking allowed?

- Smoking is prohibited in all festival areas
