

2026 Youth Track Meet FAQ

Q: When and where is the Tustin Youth Track Meet?

A: The track meet is Saturday, March 28, 2026, at Tustin High School Stadium. Address is 1171 El Camino Real, Tustin, CA 92780

Q: Who is eligible to participate?

A: Children born on or between March 28, 2011, and March 28, 2021

Q: When is registration?

A: Registration begins on January 26th and ends on March 20th

Q: How much does registration cost?

A: Registration is \$10 for all participants. There are no residents or non-resident prices.

Q: Where can I register?

A: You can register online through CivicRec or by phone with TPRD staff.

Q: Do I need to register individually if my child is a part of a track team/club?

A: We advise that you follow up with your child's track coach to see if your child has already been registered as part of the team's registration.

Q: How many events can I register for?

A: 2 events maximum per participant.

Q: Are spikes, cleats, or removable cleats allowed?

A: No. Spikes, cleats, or removable cleats are forbidden.

Q: Can I change my child's events?

A: Yes, events can be changed until March 20th. We cannot guarantee changes after March 20th.

Q: What time is my event?

A: The event schedule will be posted on our track meet website once finalized.

Q: Do I need to arrive at 8:00 am for my event?

A: Participants are recommended to check in one hour before their first event. If you have an event at 9:00 am, it is recommended to check in by 8:00 am. All participants are required to check in. If a participant was registered through a track club or coach, then the coach will check in for the entire team/club.

Q: Are the event times exact?

A: Event times are estimated and subject to change. Due to the speed of events, other events may start after the posted time. We recommend arriving at the stadium, checking in, and being ready an hour before your event begins.

Q: Can coaches or parents come onto the track?

A: No, parents and coaches must stay in spectator-only areas. The track will only be accessible to athletes and staff.

Q: What is the SCMAF-OC track meet?

A: This is the Southern California Municipal Athletic Federation Orange County track meet.

The top three (3) finishers in the 2011-2019 divisions of the Tustin Youth Track Meet are eligible to compete in the Southern California Municipal Athletic Federation Orange County track meet (additional fees will apply). Each qualifier will receive a packet with their awards that includes instructions for the following steps to participate in the SCMAF Track Meet.

Q: When and where is the SCMAF OC Track Meet?

A: The SCMAF Track and Field Championships are traditionally held the first weekend of May at Santa Ana College. More information will be available closer to the Tustin Youth Track Meet.

Q: Are photos and videos taken at the event?

A: Photos and videos may be recorded at this event and used for City marketing and social media publications. Your attendance at this event grants your permission to be included in these photos or videos.

Q: Will there be food at the event?

A: Yes, there will be a snack bar for quick snacks and refreshments, as well as a food truck.
