- The awards ceremony will take place immediately after the parade ends at the Tiller Days Main Stage. Unclaimed parade awards will remain until Sunday at the Tiller Days Information Booth. Contact Parks and Recreation at (714) 573-3326 if you are unable to claim your trophy.
- Approved entrants will receive details about check-in, staging, parking, and passes for entry into the parade staging areas by mid-September.
- **Entry Fee: \$50.00 school bands; \$25.00 all other entries.** Make checks payable to the City of Tustin.
- Parade is limited to the first 100 entries and first 10 high school bands.
- **Application deadline is Monday, September 14, 2020, at 5:00pm.**
