Bill signed up for Air Cadet Program in March 1941. He finished Basic and Pilot Training in late 1941. He was retained as an Instructor Pilot and spent the war years in that capacity. He was separated in late 1945.

In November 1947, he was recalled and assigned to SAC. He was based in Guam, San Antonio, Little Rock, England, and Omaha. In 1967, he transferred to MAC in Savannah, GA and Dover, DE. Last assignment was CO of Aerial Port Squadron, Dover, DE. Under his command was the largest Mortuary in the world, based in a hangar, serving the Viet Nam War.

During his career, he flew every Bomber up to and including the B-47. In MAC, he flew "Old Shaky," better known as C-124. He flew C-124's in and out of Viet Nam.

He retired August 1, 1968, and moved to Tustin, CA.
