



# 2021 Concerts in the Park

## Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When are Concerts held?

A: Wednesdays, July 7 through 28, 6-8pm at Peppertree Park.

Q: What bands are playing?

A: July 7 - Blaze of Jovi

July 14 - 80's All Stars

July 21- 90's Rock Show

July 28 - Queen Nation

Q: What are the current COVID-19 related guidelines that pertain to Concerts in the Park?

A: Effective June 15, California Department of Public Health (CDPH) guidelines allow for up to 10,000 people to gather for outdoor live events without any restrictions pertaining to vaccine verification/negative testing, capacity limitations, physical distancing or masking. These guidelines apply to Tustin's Concerts in the Park because the capacity of Peppertree Park falls significantly below that number. For more information click [here](#).

Q. Will there be a dance floor?

A. Yes, Peppertree Park has a dancing area in front of the stage.

Q: Will there be admission?

A: The concerts are free and spaces are on a first come, first serve basis.

Q: How early can I set up at the park?

A: Participants are not allowed to set-up prior to 3pm. Additionally, at least one person from your party must remain in your area.

Q: Can I set-up my blankets/chairs and then come back at the beginning of the concert?

A: Items cannot be left unsupervised. At least one person must stay in the designated area at all times.

Q: Can I set-up an umbrella and/or canopy?

A: Yes; however, you must put it away at the beginning of the concert.

Q: Will the playground be open?

A: Yes. Parents are asked to supervise their children.

Q: Will there be food vendors?

A: Yes. Food will be sold by food truck vendors on B Street. Currently, the Orange County Health Department is not permitting non-profit food vendors at public events, but if that changes soon we will try to work with our past vendors to bring in additional food items. You can also feel free to pack your own picnic and/or snacks.

Q: Where can I park?

A: You may park in the parking lot adjacent to the park, side streets, City Hall, public parking structure on C Street behind Rutabegorz, or public parking on Main and Prospect.
