## PERMIT PROVISIONS

1. **TRAFFIC SAFETY** - Permittee shall respect the rights & safety of the traveling public at all times. When passing or being passed, no portion of equipment or vehicle shall extend beyond the centerline of the pavement or traveled way.
2. **BRIDGES, ETC.** - Where bridges and roads are of insufficient width to comply with (1) above, flagmen shall be provided to warn and direct traffic.
3. **NIGHT MOVING** - When moving is done at night, sufficient lights and flagmen shall be employed to protect and warn traffic from all directions.
4. **MOVING IN INCLEMENT WEATHER** - Movement shall not occur in snow, fog, rain or wind when visibility is restricted to less than 1,000 feet (304.8 meters). Movement is prohibited when road surfaces are hazardous due to rain, ice, snow or frost, or when use of tire chains is mandatory. In addition, manufactured housing shall not move when the velocity of the wind is such that it causes the vehicle being towed to whip or swerve from side-to-side or fail to follow substantially in the path of the towing vehicle.  
  
Any accident caused by excessive wind or weather conditions shall be considered a prima facie violation of this condition.
5. **PARKING ON HIGHWAY** - No equipment shall be parked on the traveled way of any street or highway at night.
6. **MOVING DURING HEAVY TRAFFIC** - Moving during the morning and evening rush hour should be avoided and will not be permitted where moving creates traffic congestion or delay.
7. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR BRIDGES** - This permit invalid for crossing bridges or other structures, with load limit posted, where load exceeds said maximum weights.
8. **OVERHEAD CLEARANCE** - The permittee is responsible for clearing overhead obstructions where illegal height is an issue and in no case shall street trees be pruned or removed unless authorized by the City Engineer.
9. **PERMIT SUBJECT TO INSPECTION** - This permit must be carried on the object moved. It shall be available for inspection upon demand by any authorized agent of the Department of Public Works or any law enforcement officer.
10. **LIABILITY AND REPAIR OF DAMAGE** - In accepting this permit, the Permittee agrees to repair at his own expense and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer, any damages to the streets, structures or facilities within the Public Right-of-Way. The Permittee is responsible for all liability for personal injury or property damage which may occur through any act or omission of the Permittee when acting under this permit, and in the event any claim is made against the City of Tustin or any department, officer, or employee thereof, through, by reason of, or in connection with any such act or omission, Permittee shall defend, indemnify and hold them harmless for such claim.
11. **TIME LIMIT** - Unless specifically stated in this permit, only one move between the stated points shall be permitted by this instrument.
12. **AUTHORIZATION LIMITS** - This permit authorizes movement only over major streets of Tustin, except turnoffs to minor streets nearest to the point of destination are permitted. Names of major streets may be secured from the City Engineer.
13. **ACCEPTANCE OF PERMIT** - The moving of any load or doing any of the work outlined in this permit shall be regarded as acceptance of all terms and conditions of the permit.

**CITY OF TUSTIN**  
**GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR TRANSPORTATION PERMIT**

1. The applicant shall have an insurance certificate providing for liability insurance coverage to the applicant and to the City, which shall be named as an additional insured.
2. Load or equipment shall be an extra-legal load as defined in Section 320.5 of the California Vehicle Code.
3. Type of vehicles shall be 3-axle tractors with semi-trailers.
4. Combined vehicle length shall be a maximum of 105 feet 0 inches.
5. Maximum height shall be 16 feet 0 inches.
6. Maximum width shall be 14 feet 0 inches.
7. Maximum overall length shall be 105 feet 0 inches.
8. Maximum overhang shall be legal.
9. Weight loads shall meet purple weight per Caltrans permit.
10. Pilot car will be required on loads over 12 feet 0 inches wide.
11. Annual permit is good for one year from date identified on the permit.
12. Annual permit holder shall notify City in writing a minimum of 24-hours prior to move for approval of route.
13. No loading/unloading on City streets unless on-site conditions are prohibitive, in which case City of Tustin approval shall be required.
14. Curfew 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM. Exceptions to this curfew must be approved by the City prior to move.
15. The permit is invalid if insurance coverage has expired.
16. Annual permit fee is \$96.00. Single trip permit fee is \$15.00.

The Orange County Transportation Authority is also evaluating the regional rail system through its Countywide Rail Study (CRS). This study is assessing congested traffic corridors and identifying rail and bus enhancements to the existing transportation system. While additional rail lines and improved service are being evaluated as part of this study, stops in Tustin are not currently proposed.

## TRUCKING

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Two routes have been previously identified for designated truck travel within the City of Tustin, including Irvine Boulevard along its entire length, and Redhill Avenue in the vicinity of Irvine Boulevard.

In addition to local streets where truck travel is prohibited, weight restrictions for commercial trucking have been imposed on several facilities and these are summarized in the following table:

## HARBOR-PORT

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The closest harbor facilities are located in the City of Newport Beach.
